



JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) - Fire and Resource Assessment Program (FRAP) is currently looking to fill the position of **Environmental Scientist (Forest Research and Monitoring Specialist)**. The primary role of the job is to support CAL FIRE - FRAP scientific grant programs, research projects, monitoring efforts and assessment of wildfire and forest health in California's forests and rangelands. The selected candidate will serve as liaison between CAL FIRE and research program grantees, perform administrative management of grants to ensure their success, and contribute to internally led research and monitoring projects and programs. A key element of the job will be transferring and translating scientific findings from research, monitoring and assessment to the broader Department, landowners, policymakers and the public.

The selected candidate will join the FRAP team, whose mission is to assess conditions and trends, identify causal factors, and provide policy options for improving California's forests and rangelands. The mission of CAL FIRE is to serve and safeguard the people and protect the property and resources of California.
